**A SMALL British technology company looks like becoming a major winner from the recent flood disaster.**

Northampton-based INTAMAC expects orders of its internet-based home manager service to take off as homeowners seek to protect themselves from similar deluges in the future.

The system, which is already being sold by companies such as BT, has so far been used mainly to keep an eye out for intruders — alerting homeowners by sending them a text or voice message to their mobile or an email.

### Menacing

But Kevin Meagher, Intamac's chief executive, said it could also be used to detect menacing floods.

He said if water came into contact with the system's sensors then the alarm could be raised with up to six contacts. He told Sun City: "We can provide an early warning of flooding that can be delivered anywhere in the world. That's why we are in discussions with the insurance industry and our system is being adopted by one of the world's largest companies."
